Trail miles worked are measured as sections of trail that we are able to fully maintain to USFS standards.



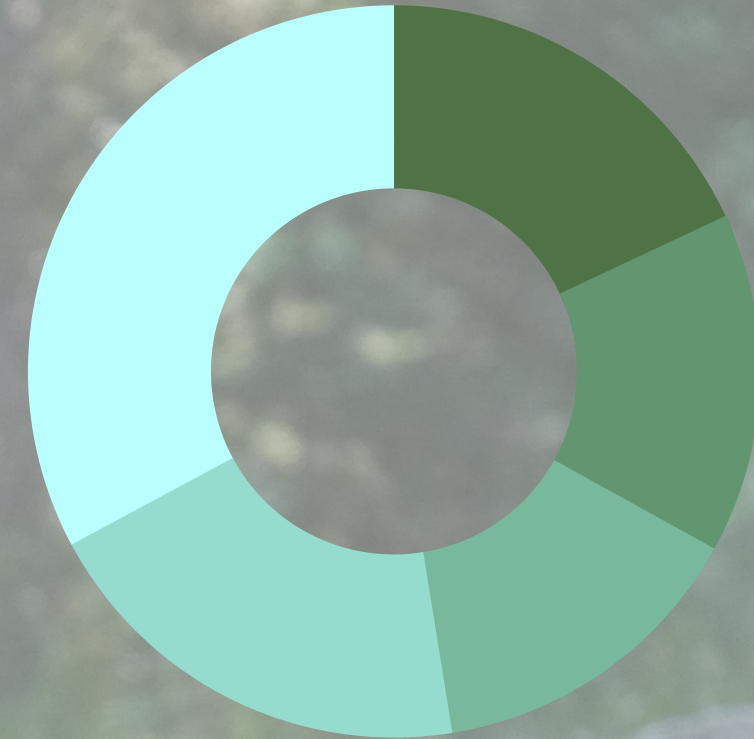
